The exhibit includes photographs of three of Gilman’s sketches. The fragile originals are in the town archives.

Early Art

John Gilman was an itinerant artist who drew pictures in exchange for room and board in the 1870’s. He sketched The View From Bennett Hill, the Sewall House, and The Reed Ham Works. In 1872, he sketched the United Church of Christ Congregational. In addition, in 1885, he may have drawn a picture of the Butters Farmhouse because it has the characteristics of his work.

Mural

The Mural in the vestibule of the Museum is the work of two Burlington High School students, Don Gorvette, and Jeff Weaver. In 1974 they received a grant to complete the mural
